





## HOW DOES IT WORK?



Based on the three main components of motion sensor, microphone and button, the figures are able to react to their surroundings and visitors.

The animation is activated:

- As soon as someone walks past (motion sensor)
- By a loud noise (microphone)
- By pressing a button (push-button)







## "Step here"

As a special solution for triggering the animation, the "Step Here" switch pad is already included with some figures. Alternatively, it is available as an optional accessory. To use the pad, you need to disconnect the push-button and connect the pad instead. The switch pad can be easily concealed under a carpet rug, doormat or decorative fabric. One step on the pad starts the animation and great scary fun is guaranteed!

Plug in & creep out!

Starts the animation once

The battery box is integrated into the body together with the electronics unit. The electronics consist of a microphone, loudspeaker, motor and the operating switch on the battery box. There are also two cables for the light sensor and the manual button.



## Technology well hidden under clothing



**ON:** The animation is triggered when the microphone detects noises or the sensor detects movement (voice sounds, LEDs flash, figure moves).

**OFF:** The animation can be started once using the manual button or the switch pad.



## Operation with battery or USB

The figures can be operated with batteries or the USB cable via a USB power source (power bank, mains adapter, etc.).



























### Fabric pumpkin

for decoration

Homemade pumpkins are a beautiful eye-catcher and, with our step-by-step instructions, are also ideal for DIY beginners.

**STEP 1:** Cut out a circle of the desired size from the fabric.

**STEP 2:** Fold over the edge of the fabric by approx. 1 cm and sew around the circle using a basting stitch. Then pull both thread ends together to create a small pouch.

**STEP 3:** Fill with absorbent cotton and then pull the thread ends completely tight and knot well.

**STEP 4:** Using a needle and thread, divide the pumpkin into sections by passing a long thread through the middle and stretching it over the fabric.

**STEP 5+6:** Optionally, a small branch (and artificial leaves) can be attached to the top center of the pumpkin with superglue.

**TIP:** Only use tear-resistant thread so that the thread ends do not break when pulled together.



#### **Utensils:**

Make-up colors in black and white, sponge, brush

- **1. Preparation:** Apply a day cream as a base to a well-cleansed face.
- **2. Foundation:** Use a sponge to apply the white color to the entire face, avoiding the eyes and mouth.
- **3. Eyes:** After the white foundation has dried, outline and fill in the eyes with black color using a thin brush.
- **4. Nose and lips:** Paint a black triangle on the nose and color the lips black.
- **5. Facial details:** Draw a slight curve from the corners of the mouth to the ears and paint vertical lines on this curve.

**Finish:** Set the make-up with a little powder or make-up powder - **DONE!** 

**TIP:** Make sure that the colors used are kind to the skin and as smudge-proof as possible.

It looks almost inconspicuous in daylight, but beware when it gets dark! Red light flickers like billowing fog inside the skull and illuminates it, accompanied by an eerie sound.







#### A look into the past may bring us a little closer to this:

Spiders already existed millions of years ago, and and some species were poisonous. It was therefore vital for our ancestors to avoid potentially dangerous animals. This instinctive caution could therefore be deeply rooted in our genes. In addition to evolutionary theory, upbringing also plays a major role. Children learn through observation and imitation and often adopt this fear when they see their parents or siblings being frightened by spiders.

Another reason for the widespread fear of spiders could be their striking appearance. Due to their many, usually hairy legs and often dark colors, they are often perceived as strange by people. Their fast and unpredictable movements also make them seem unpredictable, triggering an instinctive defensive reaction.

Perhaps we simply know too little about spiders; what we don't know often scares us. So let's do something about this fear together and take a closer look at these little eightlegged creatures:

Depending on the species and habitat, a single spider can catch and eat between 2,000 and 4,000 insects per year on average. This includes various pests such as moths, mosquitoes and flies, which are often considered a nuisance in our households. This makes spiders the perfect natural pest controllers.

To hunt insects, spiders create true masterpieces of nature - spider webs. For example, around 20 meters of spider silk are needed to complete a wheel web within an hour. These fascinating construction artists deserve our admiration for this alone. In relation to its weight, spider silk is four times as strong as steel and outshines many high-tech materials in terms of stretchability, elasticity and strength. Due to these properties, it is used in science for research into innovative materials.

Despite these positive properties, the fear of spiders, known as arachnophobia, is one of the most common phobias worldwide. Around five percent of the population is said to be affected. This fear often manifests itself in extreme physical reactions such as sweating, trembling, palpitations and even shortness of breath, and can be so severe that it significantly impairs the quality of life of those affected. Is this why spiders are an integral part of horror films, scary stories and Halloween decorations?

Because even if you don't suffer from arachnophobia, spiders provide just the right dose of goosebumps.

Perfect for Halloween decorations!

A little anecdote at the end that perfectly illustrates the creepy potential of spiders:

A dedicated Halloween friend had set out to make her Halloween party particularly authentic and decorated her home, including table decorations, with artificial spider webs and faux spiders. On the evening of the party, a panicked voice called out from the kitchen: "Help, there's a huge spider here!". Everyone laughed until someone panicked and said: "NO, it's real!". As it turned out, a real spider had found its way into the artificial decoration. A scary moment that put the creepy decorations in the shade and showed just how much spiders can freak us out.

#### **CONCLUSION**



Spider Muffins

Ingredients (for 12 muffins)

180 g flour

2 tsp baking powder

3 tsp cocoa

100 g sugar

100 g dark chocolate shavings

200 g sour cream

80 ml neutral cooking oil 2 eggs (M)

Mix the flour, baking powder and cocoa in a mixing bowl. Add the remaining ingredients (except for the chocolate chips) and mix with a mixer until smooth. Then fold the dark chocolate chips into the batter. Divide the batter between 12 muffin tins and bake in a preheated oven for 20 minutes at 180 °C (fan oven: 160 °C).

For the decoration:

200 g dark chocolate coating

100 g chocolate sprinkles

Chocolate lentils or sugar eyes (24 pieces)

Soft licorice snails (cut to size for the spider legs)

Roughly chop the chocolate coating and melt in a bain-marie (or microwave). Use a brush to coat the muffins and decorate immediately with the chocolate sprinkles. Position the "liquorice legs" and "eyes" (icing / chocolate coating / or stick) and the spooky spider muffins are ready.


## Small but mighty!

The animated decoration figure is dressed in a floor-length, almost transparent light green robe and a tattered overlay made of coarse, dark green gauze fabric. A scarf made of the same material serves as a head covering, concealing the attachment loop on the skull, which is used for hanging. Its skeletal hands are bound with a thick chain.

The skeleton man is dressed as a monk in a black hooded robe. Over his habit, which is tied with a rope, he wears a tattered stole made of coarse netting material. In his left hand, he holds a jute sack padded with cotton. With his right hand outstretched, he seems to reach for visitors while his upper body sways back and forth. Glowing red eyes and loud groaning complete the eerie effect.
